RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All competitors and spectators are advised that horse sports are dangerous and there is a risk of accidents occurring which may injure you. Morphett Vale Riding Club will not be liable or held responsible for any loss, damage or injury to horse, person, vehicles or equipment whilst on the grounds.
2. Approved Australian/New Zealand current safety standard helmets and riding boots must be worn at all times while mounted.
3. Ages of competitors are as on the day of competition.
4. RIDERS COMPETING IN RING 2 SECTION 4 WALK TROT CLASSES ARE NOT PERMITTED TO RIDE IN THE BRED-TO-RACE, OTT STANDARD BRED OR OPEN RING WITH CANTER CLASSES. RIDERS COMPETING IN CANTER CLASSES ARE NOT PERMITTED TO ENTER WALK TROT CLASSES IN RING 2 SECTION 4
5. Riders in Lead-rein classes must remain (lead-rein) for the duration of the day.
6. Walk / Trot classes are for green horses or riders that are not confident or comfortable cantering on the day. Riders in Walk / Trot classes must remain in Walk / Trot classes for the duration of the day.
7. Maiden Classes are for Horses / Riders that have not won 1st place at any open show.
8. Stewards have the right at the discretion of the judge to remove any horse/rider/handler that does not comply with the rules, is a hazard to other competitors, or behaves in an unruly manner.
9. The MVRC Committee reserves the right to alter or cancel any event or class, or to combine any event or class at its' discretion; in particular where the number of starters in any event or class is less than three the event or class may be combined with a similar event or class.
10. The judge's decision on the day is final. Anyone displaying unsportsmanlike behaviour will be asked to leave the grounds.
11. All protests must be lodged within 15 minutes of completion of the event together with a \$50.00 protest fee. If the protest is upheld the \$50.00 fee will be refunded. The committee's decision will be final.
12. Stallions not permitted on the grounds.
13. Dogs not permitted.
14. Horses are only permitted to be tied to floats that are attached to vehicles.
15. Only competing horses are permitted on the grounds.
16. Double Bridles may be worn only in Ring 1 and Ring 2 section 3.

DRESS STANDARD

No plaiting of horses is required for this show. As a show of respect to judges please present your horse in a neat and tidy manner.

Normal competition attire should be worn. Ridden Lead Rein classes may wear neat and tidy dress approved helmet and boots. Riding Club or Pony Club uniform is acceptable. Hacking jackets are not essential and if a warm day will not be required (ie, Summer Dress acceptable).

Lead Rein riders may wear neat casual dress with approved helmet and boots.

Hacking jackets not required.

Riders competing in Ring 1 Section 1 & 2 and Ring 2 Section 3. are not permitted to compete in Ring 2 Section 4 Walk Trot classes
